The Federalist #10

Written by James Madison, Federalist #10 is one of the most important readings in the US government. In this essay, Madison takes up the idea of "faction", by which he means any single group that tries to dominate the political process.

Write an essay which defines and describes the meaning of factions as defined by James Madison, using a current day example of a group in the United States. Explain what Madison meant when he stated "Liberty is to factions what air is to fire," and analyze why he believed that a republic could protect liberties better than a democracy.
