

Graduation Requirements

In order to graduate from Midland Park High School, a student must earn a total of 126 credits including course credits in each of the following areas:

- 4 years of English
- 3 years of Social Studies (Modern World History, U.S. History I & II)
- 3 years of Math
- 3 years of Science (Biology, Chemistry, Physics)
- 1 year of World Language
- 4 years Physical Education and Health
- 1 year Practical Arts: Any combination of Business and/or Consumer, Family and Life Skills
- 1 year Visual/Performing Arts
- ½ year Financial Literacy
