#### **LIMETOWN SUMMARY**

*Limetown* is a horror & sci-fi podcast created by Two-Up Productions that began airing during the summer of 2015. It focuses on Lia Haddock, an investigative journalist with the fictional station American Public Radio, in her search for the truth about what happened to the scientific settlement of Limetown, Tennessee. In 2004, all 327 inhabitants of the town vanished without a trace after a burst of strange activity. However, her interest is far from simple curiosity, as her uncle is among the missing citizens.

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## AP Literature and Composition

### Read the following two texts

*Brave New World* by Aldous Huxley

*How to Read Literature Like a Professor: A Lively and Entertaining Guide to Reading Between the Lines, Revised Edition* by Thomas C. Foster

**Assignment:** Create a slides presentation. In this presentation you should create one slide for each chapter of Foster's book.

For each slide: put the chapter number and title at the top. On the left hand side of each slide, create an overview of the most important points and characteristics of each chapter in a bulleted list of points, including any important quotes. On the right side of each slide, list 1 major (or a few small specific instances) and quotes from the novel *Brave New World* that demonstrate the concept of the chapter. Be sure you provide an explanation that clearly connects the example of the concept. All examples and quotes from *Brave New World* should be cited with both chapter and page numbers.

\*In addition to this assignment, you should expect a *Brave New World* reading test and essay question the first weeks of school.
